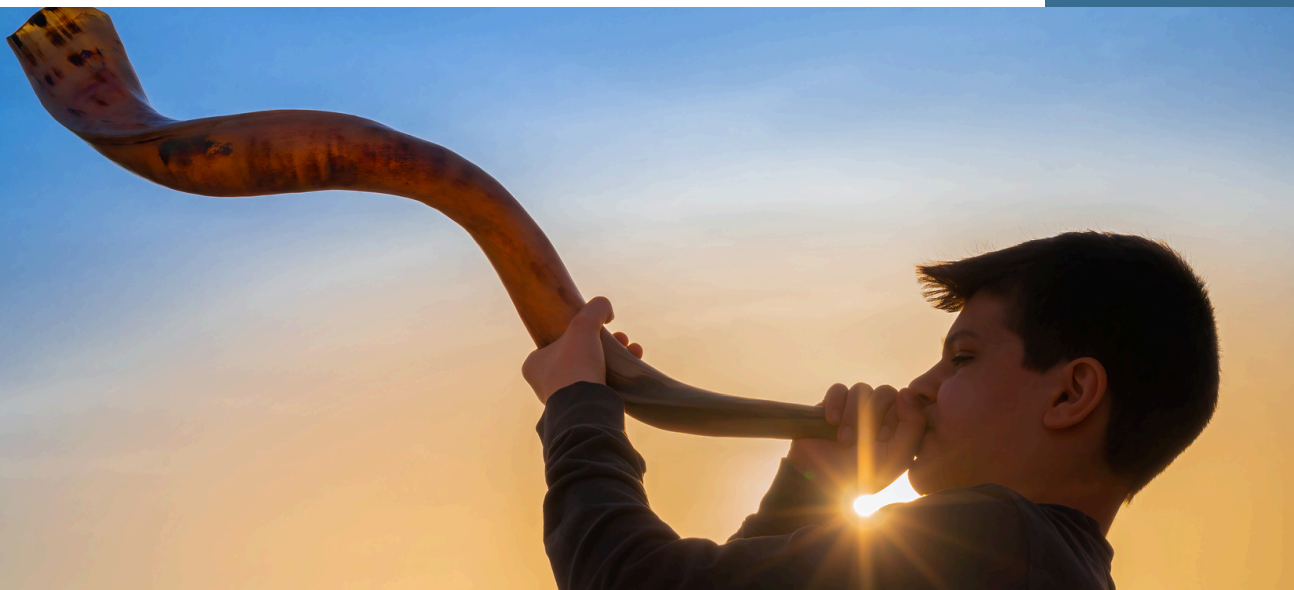

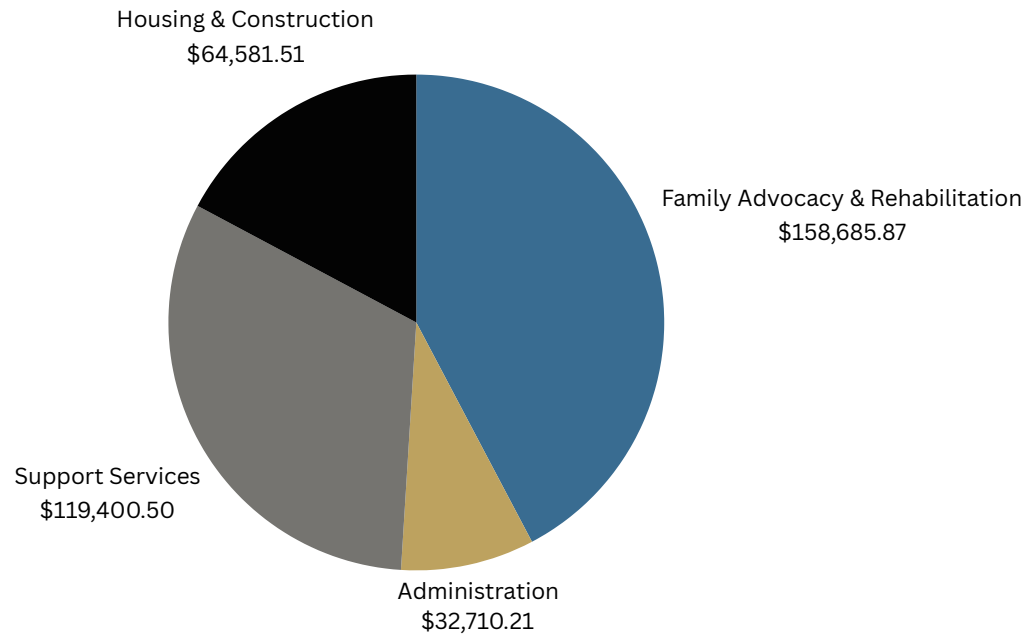

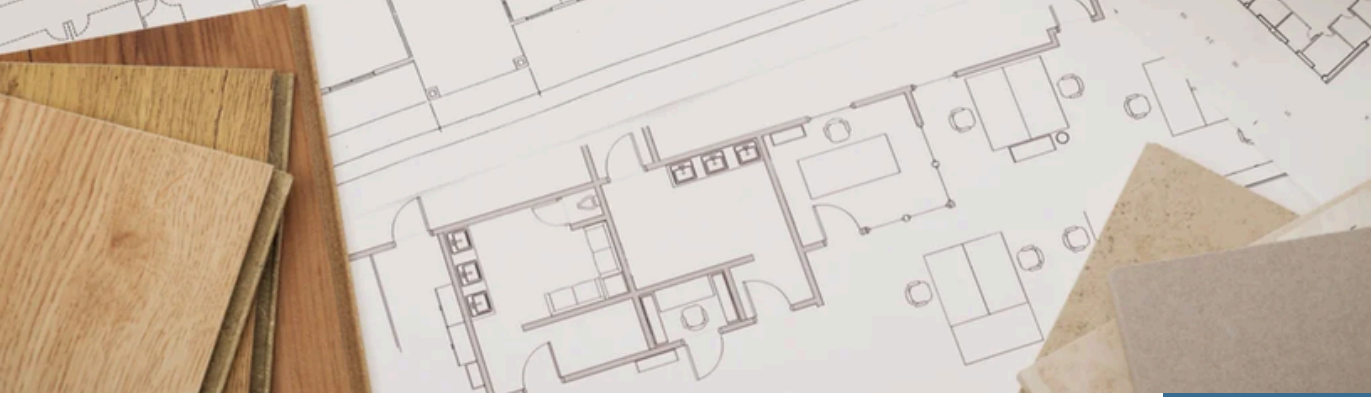

# Ministry Highlights

## FAMILY ADVOCACY & REHABILITATION

We have continued our services for the families that previously came into our care as well as provided our services to multiple new families. The families receive housing, family court advocacy, life skills training, and access to requisite therapy. Kaleb House has also partnered with a trauma therapist, a family advocate, and security personnel, as is necessary in many abusive situations. We work with the legal system to get the abusers behind bars preventing them from hurting more people.

While this could be considered the most difficult part of Kaleb House, it is also where we see some of the most beautiful sides of our work. We are able to witness women and children begin the healing process and feeling freedom from their abusers realizing that those abusers do not have all the power.

We are able to watch them begin to understand how the Father saved them and that their lives will forever be changed for the better.

With every rescue comes recovery, and a chance to share the Father's love.

## DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION

We began land clearing for multiple build sites and started construction on the first building. In October, we had general contractors come out to volunteer their time to help build. It was a great first experience working with volunteers, and one we look forward to continuing throughout 2024. We also started working on basic infrastructure around the property to make future work more manageable.

## MONETARY DONATIONS

## Goals for 2024

Kaleb House has grown immensely in 2023 which has allowed us to move at speeds we didn't think would be possible. That blessing has given us the ability to create bigger goals for 2024.

In mid-2023, construction began on the first of many buildings on site. Our goal for 2024 is to have this building done along with 1-2 care houses. We will continue to clear additional building sites while current buildings are under construction to ensure new construction is not hindered.

In conjunction with construction, we will begin designing, building, and implementing the agricultural portion of Kaleb House, including livestock and the systems needed to teach the children in our care about the Father's creation and how to work with them. Livestock will not be on property until construction is complete, but all the systems will be in place and in working order, awaiting their arrival.

Operations, Administration, and Fundraising will work together to create a cohesive work environment so that each team knows how best they can assist the other. We want to create continuity in communication across Kaleb House to better serve the mission and our supporters year after year.
